


## HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION



Select English arranges for students to stay in local homestay accommodation during their course. Staying in homestay accommodation can be an excellent way to get to know the local culture better as well as providing more opportunities to practise English.

All our homestay accommodation is carefully chosen by our Accommodation Officer, who pays regular visits to all those who host our students. The Accommodation Officer is always available to talk to students and can deal with any problems that may occur in a quick and efficient manner.

### ROOMS

Homestay accommodation is provided in single rooms for adult students and shared rooms for juniors.

### MEALS

All homestay accommodation is half-board. Breakfast and dinner are provided by the hosts. All diets can be catered for. Please let us know if you have any allergies or special dietary requirements for religious or health reasons.

### LAUNDRY

Homestay hosts will do laundry for students once a week.

### PRIVATE HOME ACCOMMODATION

Select English also offers private home accommodation. These are homestays which host more than 4 students. Private homes provide meals and laundry service as detailed above, but may offer a reduced opportunity to interact with the hosts due to the number of guests.



## ST ANDREW'S RESIDENCES

Located near the centre of the city, these residences are a 5 to 15-minute walk from the Station Road teaching site.

We use these residence buildings on the Cambridge Juniors course.

Breakfast and dinner are provided on site in the residence by the live-in house manager. Packed lunch is provided at the school.

### ROOMS

Rooms are mostly single occupancy. There are a few twin rooms. We can't guarantee availability of twin rooms, but do let us know your preference when booking.

### EN-SUITE BATHROOMS

Most bedrooms have en-suite bathrooms.

### LAUNDRY

Laundry service is offered in the middle of each two-week course. Bed linen is provided. We ask students to bring their own towel.

### INTERNET

Wifi is provided at the residence and is free of charge.

### MEALS

You'll be provided with breakfast and dinner and the residence and a packed lunch at school. There's always fresh fruit and snacks available in the residence common rooms.

The Railyard residence is available for students aged 18+ during July and August. Located at Station Place, it's a short 5-minute walk to our Station Road site, and 15 minutes' walk from the city centre. Accommodation is self catering. Rooms are in flats of 6 rooms, sharing a kitchen and living space. All rooms are en-suite.

### ROOMS

Rooms are offered as single occupancy, though we do have twin rooms available for a pair of students travelling together and staying for the same dates.

### BATHROOMS

All rooms are single, en-suite.

### INTERNET

Wifi is provided at the Railyard residence and is free of charge.

### LAUNDRY

Bed linen is provided for students. There are washing and drying machines on site for students to use. These are operated by tokens that can be brought from the reception desk at Railyard.

### MEALS

The Railyard residence is self catering. You'll have access to the shared kitchen in your flat to prepare meals. There are several cafes and restaurants within a few minutes' walk of the residence.

We believe that children learn best by doing. Our classes aim to actively engage

our pupils in using English with fun, enjoyable activities, project work and the use of technology. Lessons include songs, games, pair work and group work, as well as individual help from qualified language teachers. We encourage the children on our summer courses to feel positive and confident about learning English, so that they will return home motivated to continue with their language studies.

Our summer courses for adults focus on real language use. We use a wide variety of materials

including newspapers, TV and radio programmes and the internet. Lessons include pair work and group discussions, pronunciation practice and help with grammar problems, as well as individual guidance from qualified English language teachers. We encourage students to use English as much as possible during their course, both inside and outside the classroom.

## STUDENT WELFARE

Student welfare is our number one priority on all our summer courses. Classes are small (no more than 16 students per class) and all activities are supervised, with staff ratios of 1:15 on the Young Learner courses and 1:20 on the Teens and Young Adults (aged under 18) courses.

Each course has first-aid trained staff on site.

We can help students to access medical services they may need. These include pharmacists, doctors, dentists and orthodontists, optometrists, and counselling services (these may have extra charges).

We carefully select and check our host families before they can host for Select English.

Our hosts are regularly visited by the Accommodation Officer. We also monitor homestays through student feedback.

All of our halls of residences have live-in managers who care for our students.

All house managers are DBS checked and have first aid and fire training.

All of the residences are within walking distance of the school.


